- 20' DV; 40' DV; 40' HC
- 20' & 40' O/T
- 20' & 40' FR
- 20' & 40' RF
- 20' & 40' TC
- Break Bulk
- Bulk

Abbreviations:

- DV = Dry Van; O/T = Open Top; FR = Flat Rack
- RF = Refrigerated; TC = Tank Container

Air / LCL Freight

- Weight / Volume consideration
- SEA CARGO – 1 CBM = 1 M/T (LCL)
Except US Inland Moments
- Volume OR Weight whichever is higher
- AIR CARGO – 6000 cm³ = 1 Kg
- Actual Weight or Volumetric Weight whichever is higher

Precautions to be taken by exporter

- L/C Conditions
- Shipping Instructions
- Packing Instructions
- Nomination – Line / Agency
- Inspection – Required / Not Required
- Fumigation – For Wooden Packing Material
- Warehouse to Warehouse Insurance
- Stuffing Survey
- Law of the Land (Importing Country)
